Scotlandspeople continues to increase access to records with the following recent additions:

Military Service Appeals Tribunal records from 1916 - 1918 are now available.

Now online are births registered in 1915, marriages in 1940, and deaths in 1965. The 1940 marriages are very significant because that year saw the introduction of civil marriages by registrars.

The Catholic Parish Registers are records of sacramental events recorded by the Roman Catholic Church in Scotland between 1703 and 1903. The registers comprise records of births and baptisms, marriages, deaths and burials, and also a small set of fascinating records of communicants, sick calls, first confessions and seat rents.
