Lancashire Certificate Services

Since re-opening on Tuesday 29th March, the Certificates Service office is located in the Lancashire Archives building on Bow Lane, Preston, PR1 2RE. Ordering on-line and by phone (0300 123 6705) has not changed, certificates will be produced and posted out as before.

Visiting in person to order certificates is a little different as the office is not accessible to the public. On entering Lancashire Archives it is necessary to ask at the main reception desk for Certificate Services. A phone call will be placed to the office, and someone will come out to meet you to take details.

Certificates cost £10.00, but if required for collection the same day they will be subject to an additional £10.00 fee.
Cheques or postal orders should be made payable to Lancashire County Council.

It is also important to note that when applying in person there may be a waiting time as registers are stored at some distance from the office, and retrieval and production of a certificate is likely to take a little longer than it did previously.

(N.B. It may be advisable to telephone Certificate Services to confirm opening times.
Lancashire Archives is closing on Mondays, but it's understood that it will still be possible to access the Certificate Service on that day. However, best to check before visiting.
