The General Register Office (GRO) is looking at different ways of providing civil registration services to customers, and as part of that it is testing customer demand for records in PDF format. The GRO ran earlier pilots, and it has been decided to continue from 12th October 2017 for a minimum of 3 months. PDF copies of historic births (1837 - 1916) or death entries (1837 – 1957) can be ordered for a fee of £6.00. A GRO index reference must be provided with each application.
